## **CONSTITUITION**

## **ARTICLE 1 – NAME**

The name of this association is and shall be
"MAJOR WALDRON SPORTSMEN'S ASSOCIATION"
agreeably to
the articles and charter of incorporation,
STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE.

- <u>Section 1</u> The development of greater opportunities for the enjoyment of outdoors as an essential part of the character building and the spiritual and physical development of our people, especially boys and girls.
- <u>Section 2</u> To assure a copious supply of pure water, and to safeguard the public health and to conserve aquatic life by the elimination of pollution and floods.
- <u>Section 3</u> To encourage a more universal appreciation of the aesthetic and economic value of and the protection and restoration of our forests, wild flowers and wild life, especially our fish, game, valuable furbearers and wild birds, and prevent indiscriminate drainage thereof.
- <u>Section 4</u> To prevent forest and grass fires and secure strict observance of the laws protecting wild life; also urge the protection of the property of others.
- <u>Section 5</u> To educate the public, especially the young, to the imperative need of these objects, to unify the activities of all persons therein interested, and encourage and work for legislation designed to accomplish these purposes.
- **Section 6** To restore and transmit to posterity the outdoor America of our ancestors, insofar as this may be possible

## ARTICLE 3 DISSOLUTION

The Association may be dissolved at any time, either at a special, regular, or annual meeting, by vote of a two-thirds majority of the active members of this Association, entitled to vote; further, in the event this Association is dissolved for any reason and/or purpose whatsoever, any and all property belonging to said Association, whether real, personal, or mixed and wherever situate, shall be transferred to the Fish and Game Department for the State of New Hampshire, to be used by said Fish and Game Department for the purposes of continuing to promote the objectives for which this Association was formed, as nearly as possible, without restricting said Fish and Game Department in any manner, in using said property as in its judgment shall be most beneficial to the sportsmen of the State of New Hampshire; and further, the President of this Association shall have authority to sign, in the name of this Association, whatever documents may be necessary to make such transfer of its property in the dissolution of this Association.
