

MWSA WORK PROGRAM AND YOUR APPLICATION

Greetings

Did you know that the Work Program has been in effect for over 15 years? The Work Program requires that a member devote a minimum of 5 hours of their time per year. The program is designed to maintain the buildings, grounds, ranges, shooting programs, Wednesday Night Shoots, work the Skeet Range, be a Range Safety Officer and much more. Additionally, you can satisfy this requirement by volunteering with other things in the club, such as; assist in cleaning the club's rifles and pistols, be a Board Member, weekly cleaning of the club areas, shovel snow and on and on – like any home or business, the Club needs care and maintenance. Contact any Board Member or Program Chairman for things to do to satisfy the requirement. Also, by attending a Monthly Meeting, you can meet the people who need you to assist them in making our Club a better place to shoot at.

When you submit your Membership Renewal you will need to fall under one of the following bullets;

- If you worked please provide your work-party log showing hours worked. It is the individual's responsibility to provide this.
- A check for \$35.00 in place of working (aka OPT OUT)
- Are you exempt because of range operations, shooting program(s), a member of the Board? Provide verification of this.

If you do not provide the verification, or payment, your renewal will be placed on a "hold" status. I will then contact you for what needs to be done to complete your renewal. If you feel that you satisfied the requirement in a manner other than what was listed, please contact a Board Member to provide an exemption.

Again, it is an individual responsibility to provide any information.

If you have any comments, concerns, or suggestions, please contact a Board Member for clarification.
